

eRL-BE365 & eRL-FE595 eRL System Quick Setup Instruction

Thank you for choosing the **eRL System**!

Please follow the steps below to setup your **eRL System**. For additional support, please visit part 2 of the <https://erentallock.com/faq/> page.

STEP 1: Login to the eRL Program

Visit <https://code.erentallock.com/> and login using your online account credentials.

Note:

Your **Username** and the default **Password (123456)** were sent to the email address used for your **eRL Lock** purchase, along with your tracking number and invoice. Please check that email for your login details.

STEP 2: Register your eRL Lock

Navigate to **Lock Management** → **Add**. On pop up page, enter your **eRL Lock** details and click **Submit**.

Note:

- Under “**Group Address**”, select “**No Group**”.
- Select the correct Lock Model: **eRL-BE365** or **eRL-FE595**.
- Under “**Installed On**”, select “**Guest Room Door**”.
- Choose the appropriate “**Time Zone**” for your property.

STEP 3: Write down your new private Master Code

- 1) Navigate to **Lock Management** → **Show/Hide private Master Code**.
- 2) Write down the new **private Master Code** generated by the **eRL program**.

STEP 4: Install your eRL Lock

- 1) Follow the instructions in the Schlage **Installation Manual** provided with your **eRL Lock**. You can also watch the installation video in Part 2 of the <https://erentallock.com/faq/> page.
- 2) Open the **eRL Lock's** back cover to connect the wire harness for the battery and connect 9V battery to the wire harness.

Note:

- You don't need the **Program Code** on the **Yellow Sticker** mentioned in the Schlage **Installation Manual** to set up your **eRL Lock**.
- If your property is remote, we recommend using a new battery.
- For assistance installing the **eRL-BE365 Lock**, click item 4.5 of the <https://erentallock.com/faq/> page to watch the video.

STEP 5: Set the new private Master Code, which you WRITE DOWN in STEP 3, on your eRL Lock

- 1) Enter the following keypad command to set the new **private Master Code**, **which MUST match the new private Master Code you WRITE DOWN in STEP 3:**

123456		0		new private Master Code		new private Master Code again
--------	---	---	---	-------------------------	---	-------------------------------

- 2) Test the new **private Master Code** by entering the following keypad command:

new private Master Code which you WRITE DOWN in STEP 3  **3** 

If the **eRL Lock** unlocks (green light flashes with an ascending tones), the new **private Master Code** has been set successfully.

STEP 6: Set the Date and Time on your eRL Lock

Enter the following keypad command to set the date and time:

new private Master Code  **1**  **YY – MM – DD – HH – MM**

Note:

- **YY-MM-DD-HH-MM** corresponds to **Year-Month-Day-Hour-Minute**
- The time **MUST** be in **Military (24-Hour) Time Format**. The date and time **MUST** be entered in two digits. For example, year 2024 is entered as 24, January as 01, and 5:08 PM as 17:08 in **24-hour format**.
- During Daylight Saving Time (DST), do not use the DST time. Instead, set the standard time by shifting one hour back. For example, if the current DST time is 14:28, set the time as 13:28 on your **eRL Lock**.

STEP 7: Test your entire setup

- 1) Generate **“For Guest” Access Code** that is valid for current hour. For example, if the current time is January 8th, 2024, 2:32 PM, generate the **Access Code** with check-in time as January 8th, 2024, 2:00 PM, and check-out time as January 8th, 2024, 2:59 PM.
- 2) Enter the generated **Access Code** to ensure it unlocks the **eRL Lock**.

You’re ready to use the eRL System!

You can now remotely control your property access using the **Desktop Web Version** of the **eRL Program**.
